

## Wikipedia Entry Activity

In advanced Spanish classes or Gender and Sexuality Studies courses we reflect on how exclusionary the Internet continues to be for certain groups. Thus, I often ask the students to write a Wikipedia entry, editing an existing entry and/or rewriting it in Spanish. For some years now The Crunk Feminist Collective and other feminist groups have engaged in edit-a-thons and edit sessions where they have added or edited articles on Wikipedia. My students do this activity in groups, and it reinforces their research skills, their writing abilities, and their digital competency.
